AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF EATONTOWN AMENDING

CHAPTER 161 FIRE PREVENTION, SECTION 9 PERMIT FEES

WHEREAS, the Borough Fire Official has proposed to the Borough Council and the Borough Administrator to modernize and update the administrative fees charged in connection inspections of non-life-hazard-use businesses located within the Borough; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council believes it to be in the best interest of its residents to abide by the recommendation of the Borough Fire Official to simplify the calculation of inspection fees and ensure that the fees charged in connection inspections of non-life-hazard-use businesses located within the Borough are commensurate with the associated administrative burden of same.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the Borough Council of the Borough of Eatontown, County of Monmouth and State of New Jersey that it hereby amends the Borough Code as follows:

The contents of Chapter 161-9(b) shall be deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

b. Mercantile, Factories, Warehouses, Repair shops, Business offices and all other non-life hazard businesses shall be inspected annually by the Bureau of Fire Prevention with a fee schedule of:

(a) \$55 for the first 1000 square feet.

(b) \$10 for each additional 1000 square feet.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that

- A. All other Ordinances or provisions of the Code of the Borough of Eatontown or parts thereof, which are inconsistent with any provisions in this Ordinance, are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict or inconsistency.
- B. If any provision or portion of this Chapter is held to be unconstitutional, preempted by Federal or State Law or otherwise invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining provisions of this chapter shall not be invalidated.
- C. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication as required by law.
