AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF EATONTOWN AMENDING CHAPTER 312, "VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC", ARTICLE III
"PARKING, STOPPING OR STANDING", SECTION 312-5 "PARKING PROHIBITED DURING CERTAIN HOURS" OF THE
BOROUGH CODE, TO REMOVE OVERNIGHT PARKING LIMITATIONS DURING WEEKEND HOURS

WHEREAS, the Borough currently has enacted rules and regulations restricting overnight parking of vehicles on streets generally except for Sunday between the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 6 a.m.; and

WHEREAS, the Borough wants to ease certain restrictions to allow overnight parking of vehicles on streets for the entire weekend to include Saturday morning between the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m.; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council believes it is in the best interest of its residents to update the Borough Code to allow overnight street parking for vehicles during the entire weekend.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the Borough Council of the Borough of Eatontown, County of Monmouth and State of New Jersey that it hereby amends Chapter 312, Article III, Section 312-5 of the Borough Code entitled "Parking Prohibited in During Certain Hours" as follows:

Section 312-5 Parking prohibited during certain hours.

No person shall park a vehicle between the hours specified in Schedule II (§ 312-33) of any day (except Saturdays, Sundays and public holidays) upon any of the streets or parts of streets described in said Schedule II attached to and made a part of this Part 1.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that

- A. All other Ordinances or provisions of the Code of the Borough of Eatontown or parts thereof, which are inconsistent with any provisions in this Ordinance, are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict or inconsistency.
- B. If any provision or portion of this Chapter is held to be unconstitutional, preempted by Federal or State Law or otherwise invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining provisions of this chapter shall not be invalidated.
- C. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication as required by law.


