

ORDINANCE 05-2021

BOROUGH OF EATONTOWN
COUNTY OF MONMOUTH, STATE OF NEW JERSEY

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 312 OF THE BOROUGH CODE ENTITLED "VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC"
SECTION 39 ENTITLED "SCHEDULE VIII: STOP INTERSECTIONS"
TO ADD A 4-WAY STOP AT CLINTON AVENUE AND SOUTH STREET

WHEREAS, the Borough of Eatontown (the "Borough") is authorized, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40:67-1 to prescribe the manner in which any local street may be used; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 312-12 of the Borough Code designates certain intersections in the Borough as stop intersections as described in Schedule VIII at section 312-39; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council desires to enhance the safety of the intersection at Clinton Avenue and South Street by installing a 4-way stop;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the by the BOROUGH COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF EATONTOWN, IN THE COUNTY OF MONMOUTH, STATE OF NEW JERSEY that Chapter 312, Section 39, entitled "Schedule VIII: Stop Intersections" of the Borough Code is hereby amended as follows:

Section 312-39, entitled "Schedule VIII: Stop Intersections" is hereby amended by adding the intersections and stop sign installations designated below:

Intersection	Stop Sign on
Clinton Avenue and South Street	Both Roads-All Directions

IT IS FURTHER ORDAINED, that if any section, paragraph, subsection, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged by the courts to be invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the section, paragraph, subsection, clause or provisions so adjudicated, and the remainder of the Ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDAINED that any ordinances or parts thereof in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are repealed to the extent of such conflict.


IT IS FURTHER ORDAINED that this Ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication in accordance with applicable law.
